



IMMUNIZATION EXEMPTION FORM

Students at Brightworth Academy may request an exemption from required immunization according to State of Tennessee policies. Healthcare providers may exempt a student from vaccination if there is a significant risk factor due to the student's current health or medical condition. There are also religious grounds that are recognized by the State of Tennessee that can exempt a student from immunizations if immunizations conflict with the individual's religious practices or tenets.

The form below must be signed by a licensed healthcare provider or a parent/guardian and submitted to Brightworth Academy's health services department.

Please Note: Vaccines provide protection for many critical illnesses and are proven safe for most individuals, however, the government has exemptions available for individuals with medical issues or religious grounds - Pursuant to Tennessee Annotated Code 49-6-5001(b)(2).

In accordance with state policies, if there is an outbreak event, individuals that are exempt will be subject to exclusion from school and quarantine.
